It's that time of the year again! It's time for our annual July BBQ to be held on **Saturday, July 13<sup>th</sup>, 2019** at **Old Borges Ranch** in the foothills of Walnut Creek located at **1035 Castle Rock Road**. Our BBQ will go from **2:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m.** We will start with snacks and drinks. Dinner will be catered by our very own Tony Stankoff & Company and be served at 4:00 p.m. Our coin drawing will follow dinner and be held around 5:00 p.m

**The menu is as follows:** marinated tri-tip, BBQ chicken quarters, mixed green salad with House Italian dressing, baked beans, fresh corn, scalloped potatoes, potato chips, watermelon, soft drinks, and cookies. Feel free to bring some snacks to share before the dinner. Ice cold bottled water will be made available during the whole event. Admission price is **\$20 per person** which will be collected at our May and June meetings.

## Directions:

From Highway 680, take the Treat Blvd exit and head east on Treat toward Mt. Diablo. In about one mile, turn right onto Bancroft Road. As you cross over Ygnacio Valley Road, it turns into Walnut Avenue. Continue on Walnut Avenue for about 1.5 miles. Turn right at the traffic circle onto Oak Grove Road. As you pass Northgate High School on your right the road turns into Castle Rock Road. Continue for about one mile and turn right at the Old Borges Ranch sign. Enter the gate and follow the signs on the one lane private road for  $\frac{3}{4}$  of a mile to the **lower parking lot**. Due to scheduled construction in the upper parking lot picnic area, we will be holding the event at the lower parking area. If construction has not begun, then we will meet at the upper parking lot area. Again, follow the signs.

## Diablo Numismatic Society Auction Rules

DNS auctions will take place 4 times per year, in conjunction with regular monthly meetings. Dates will be published in the Die Break. The purpose of the auction is to let members raise cash from unneeded or unproductive coins from their collections. Specifically, the purpose is not to put items up for bid at unreasonable prices. Accordingly, there will be no reserves or "holds" on items put up for bid. Consignors should list a "value" for each item and must cite the source of that estimated value.

We will also solicit auction items from dealers at prices which should entice bidders.

Club members will be limited to five submissions per auctions, unless otherwise announced. They must fill out an entry form describing each lot and containing the information listed in the foregoing paragraph. Priority will be given to members who fill out the entry form and submit it to the auction coordinator, Bill Hickman, by e-mail or delivery at least 7 days prior to the meeting. Last minute entries will be accepted, assuming there is space available, but should be delivered to the coordinator prior to the start of the meeting. Each auction will be limited to 30 lots. All submissions will be accepted at the discretion of the auction coordinator.
