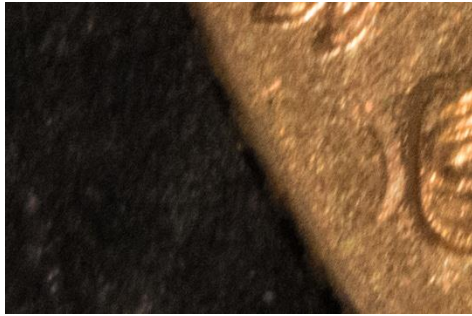

## **Identify This Coin: What's wrong with the mintmark?**



**This is a perfect example of damage done to a coin that has been placed in a bezel and worn on a charm bracelet. The bezel wore off details around the rim of the coin and most of the mint mark.**

**Dealers consider these damaged coins and the value is greatly reduced.**

**Fortunately, this coin was not soldered into the bezel, which would have caused even more damage.**
