Washington Quarters Type "B" Reverse - FS-901


I've heard about these quarters, but I never knew much about them and I wasn't sure how to identify them. I like Washington quarters and I have both an uncirculated set and a circulated set; both sets 1932 to current, all dates and mints. I've been thinking about adding die varieties to the uncirculated set and now, thanks to third party grading, I have found some type "B" reverses. There are nine years - 1956 to 1964, and sitting in a dealer's case were PCGS graded Washington quarters with the type "B" reverse, and labeled as such. Not hard to find them when they are labeled.

A type "B" reverse is a business strike coin made with a retired proof reverse die. The mint did not make these by accident. Towards the end of the year's production the mint ran out of the regular business strike reverse dies and with not enough time to make new dies, the officials in charge decided to use the retired proof reverse dies to finish the year's production.

These can be found in relatively high grades - MS 65 to MS 67. The 1956 and 1961 are the two difficult type "B's" to find in the higher grades. To date, no type "B" reverses in this date range have been found from the Denver mint.

Some of the differences of the type "B" reverse are: different spacing on some of the letters, the eagle's talons are more pronounced, and a general sharpness of detail because of the proof die.

I have most of them, I'm just missing three: 1961, 1962, and 1963. Most of mine are MS 65 and MS 66's, with the 1964 an MS 63. I plan on improving the 1964 if possible.

Miscellaneous Information:

Troy Weights

- 1 Troy ounce = 480 grains, or 31.103 grams, or 1.097 Avoirdupois ounces
- 1 Avoirdupois ounce = 437.5 grains, or 28.349 grams, or .911 Troy ounce
- 1 Troy pound = 5760 grains, or .8228 Avoirdupois pound
- 1 Avoirdupois pound = 7000 grains or 1.215 Troy pounds.

The grain measure is the same for both (1 grain Troy = 1 grain Avoirdupois).

Troy ounces are bigger than Avoirdupois ounces, but Troy pounds are slightly smaller than Avoirdupois pounds.

There are 12 Troy ounces to a Troy pound and there are 16 Avoirdupois ounces to an Avoirdupois pound.
