Legislation is being considered under U.S. Congress House bill-H.R. 3757 which would require the United States Mint to produce two U.S. Silver Dollars under the Commemorative Coin Program with the dates of 2021. These two coins will be of the original designs and specifications of both the Peace and Morgan silver dollars in uncirculated and proof finishes. WOW...I am all in for this! There will be more about this in future meetings and how each of us can participate in this bill by writing our Congressperson a letter of support.

ATTENTION ALL COIN COLLECTORS

SUPPORT U.S. CONGRESS HOUSE BILL - H.R. 3757

CALL, EMAIL OR WRITE YOUR U.S. CONGRESSPERSON

COMMEMORATIVE COIN PROGRAM - This legislation, H.R. 3757, "1921 Silver Dollar Commemorative Coin Act" will require the United States Mint to produce two U.S. Silver Dollars (Morgan and Peace Dollars) dated 2021.

COIN DESIGNS - These two silver dollars will be minted from the original design work of George T. Morgan and Anthony de Francicsci. The only change will be the date to 2021.

METAL CONTENT - The coins will be not less than 90% silver.

COIN SIZES - They will be as the original sized silver dollars in uncirculated and proof finishes.

COST - The pricing has yet to be determined. 40% of the surcharges will go back to numismatics through the American Numismatic Association as directed by law. Since the restart of the Mint's commemorative coin program in 1982 coin surcharges have supported many worthy causes and projects. This will be the first time that the surcharge funds will be used to support numismatics.

Diablo Numismatic Society Auction Rules

DNS auctions will take place 4 times per year, in conjunction with regular monthly meetings. Dates will be published in the Die Break. The purpose of the auction is to let members raise cash from unneeded or unproductive coins from their collections. Specifically, the purpose is not to put items up for bid at unreasonable prices. Accordingly, there will be no reserves or "holds" on items put up for bid. Consignors should list a "value" for each item and must cite the source of that estimated value.

We will also solicit auction items from dealers at prices which should entice bidders.

Club members will be limited to five submissions per auctions, unless otherwise announced. They must fill out an entry form describing each lot and containing the information listed in the foregoing paragraph. Priority will be given to members who fill out the entry form and submit it to the auction coordinator, Bill Hickman, by e-mail or delivery at least 7 days prior to the meeting. Last minute entries will be accepted, assuming there is space available, but should be delivered to the coordinator prior to the start of the meeting. Each auction will be limited to 30 lots. All submissions will be accepted at the discretion of the auction coordinator.

August Auction Results

At our August auction, there were 24 items. All were sold in 16 minutes for a total of \$ 601. Highlights of the auction were a 1991 tenth ounce gold Chinese Panda, which sold for \$ 160 and an uncut sheet of 32 \$ 2 bills which went for \$ 80. Our next auction is tentatively scheduled for the November meeting. Those who wish to consign items must fill out the entry form included herein, in duplicate, or may not be able to participate
