## Legislation is calling for $\mathbf{1 2 0}$ commemorative coins for one program in 2023

The U.S. House of Representatives is considering recognizing 20 men in a commemorative coin program for 2023. And according to the bill, that would result in 120 different coins.

The coins would honor the 19 firefighters of the Granite Mountain Hotshots who lost their lives while fighting the Yarnell Hill fire in Arizona on June 30th, 2013 and to honor the sole survivor.
Rep. Paul Gosar's bill will seek 20 different designs in Half dollar, Uncirculated and Proof dollars, and a gold $\$ 5$ coin. Each coin will honor a different firefighter. This would cost over $\$ 30,000.00$ if you were to purchase each and every coin in the series. I hope this does not pass. One design honoring all who perished and the sole survivor is all that is needed.

This violates the law of producing only 2 commemorative coins per year. This law was passed to prevent the long programs of the early commemoratives.

The bill's sponsor's office did not respond to Coin World's inquiries about the scope of the program.

## Nice Windfall While Searching Rolls

One of our members, William Silvey, routinely buys boxes of Lincoln cents from his bank and searches them for rare varieties or anything unusual. On his latest trip to the bank, he also asked if they had any half dollar rolls. The teller replied that she just received $\$ 50.00$ in halves from a customer. Two twenty dollar rolls and one ten dollar roll, he bought them all. As he opened one of the rolls he was almost blinded by the brilliance of the coins. He called me about them and I had him come to my house. While we were going through the coins we discovered that many of them were proof coins. 39 coins were proofs. Almost a complete date run from 1964 to 1999, only missing 4 coins; 1985, 1987, 1989, and 1999.
Only 5 coins were circulated, the rest appear to be uncirculated. I haven't had a chance to catalog these yet, William will be putting these Unc coins in an album, then we will find out what is missing.

There were two special mint set halves (1966 and 1967) that appear to be exceptional specimens and I think they should be third party graded. High-grade SMS halves are rare.

I think William will have more to say about his find at the meeting. I also asked him to bring the exceptional SMS halves to the meeting for show and tell and members opinions on whether they should be graded or not.
